

Find words by moving from one letter to any adjoining letter. In the first puzzle, you'll be searching for 3- and 4-letter fruits and vegetables (like FIG) and in the second puzzle, look for 5-letter fruits and vegetables. You may start a word with any letter in the diagram. In forming a word you may return to a letter as often as you wish, but do not stand on a letter using it twice in direct succession. We found 12 fruits and vegetables in the first diagram and 11 in the second.
