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How to Solve Sudoku Puzzles

To solve a Sudoku puzzle, place a number into each box so that each row across, each column down, and each small 9-box square within the larger diagram (there are 9 of these) will contain every number from 1 through 9. In other words, no number will appear more than once in any row, column, or smaller 9-box square. Working with the numbers already given as a guide, complete each diagram with the missing numbers that will lead to the correct solution.

How to Solve Black Magic Puzzles

Blacken in exactly ten of the empty squares in the grid in such a way that each numbered square accurately indicates how many immediately adjacent squares are black. For example, a square containing “3” indicates that three and only three of the adjacent squares, moving horizontally, vertically, or diagonally, are black. It may be helpful to mark any square that you decide is not black with “0.”
