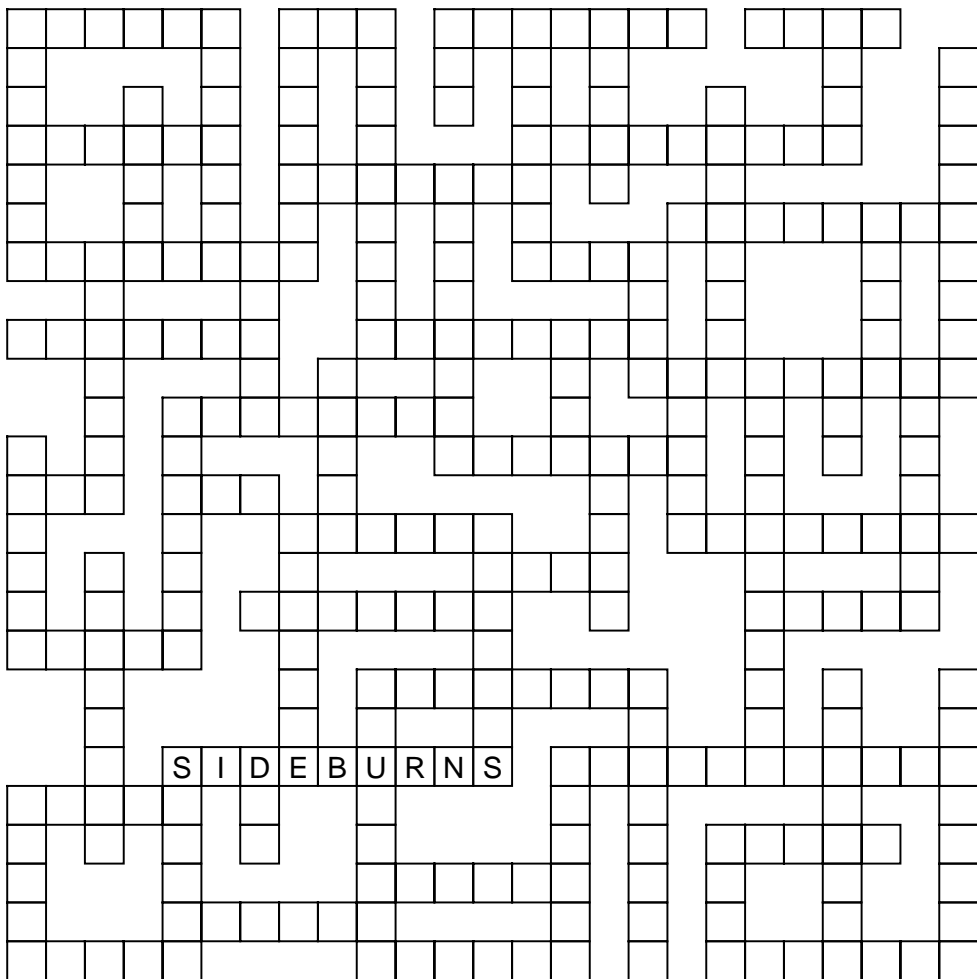

## How to Solve Frameworks

You do not need a dictionary to solve a Framework puzzle, only a bit of patience and concentration. The words in the list are given alphabetically according to the number of letters they have. Fit them into their proper places in the diagram reading across and down. When you are sure of the location of a word, put it into the diagram and cross it off the word list. As you proceed and have fewer words remaining in the word list, solving the puzzle gets easier. Sometimes it helps to start with the longer entries or with those words in any length group containing just a few entries. Many solvers like to work in pencil, writing in possible arrangements of words until one works.
